Practice Insights announces the implementation of technical fixes within the application to support Merit-Based Incentive Payment System (MIPS) requirements.

## MIPS Quality Measures Dashboard

Starting Monday, April 6, 2026:

- Users can view data from Q1 2026 using the **Time Period** drop-down in the dashboard. This will also provide users with the ability to view the **Practice Insights Avg. % Performance** column Q1 2026 data.
- Updated MIPS 2026 Benchmark file to reflect accurate decile points for the 2026 performance year.
